

## Coordinator of Online MSW – School of Social Work Job No. 10144

The West Virginia University School of Social Work (<a href="http://socialwork.wvu.edu">http://socialwork.wvu.edu</a>) seeks a Coordinator for a new online MSW program targeted to begin in fall 2019. The selected candidate will coordinate a new online MSW program targeted to begin in fall 2019. The position also includes teaching and advising in the program. The position is a twelve-month, full-time, non-tenure track position that carries the academic rank of Clinical Instructor or Clinical Assistant Professor, depending on the candidate's level of graduate education. Clinical faculty appointments at WVU are full-time, promotable, renewable non-tenure track appointments.

Qualifications include a CSWE-accredited master's degree in social work (candidates who also have a doctoral degree will be eligible for appointment at the rank of Clinical Assistant Professor); two years post-MSW professional practice experience; documented ability to teach effectively in an online setting; and documented ability to develop online courses and coordinate the new program.

The WVU School of Social Work is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education and enrolls approximately 350 students at the BSW and MSW levels. The MSW Program offers a specialization in Advanced Integrated Practice. The School is also exploring the development of a PhD degree program in social work. We are especially interested in candidates who, through their research, teaching, and/or service, will contribute to the diversity and excellence of the academic community.

WVU is a R1 research land grant university located within 90 minutes of Pittsburgh and 3.5 hours from the Washington/Baltimore area. Morgantown has been recognized as one of the most livable small cities in the U.S. There are extensive recreational opportunities, excellent public schools, and a supportive University environment in which to develop a visible and productive career.
